# A Few Words about Fear

One of the most potent weapons that our enemy, the Devil, uses against us is fear. Focusing too much on fear can paralyze us, can keep us from doing what we sometimes must do, what we must do even in the face of fear.

I have heard it said that the 2 uppermost fears for many/most people are:

- 1) Fear of death
- 2) Fear of public speaking

Those sound reasonable. Don't they? However, as Christ's disciples, we must do better than being reasonable. Jesus calls us to holiness, not reasonableness. Concern for our physical health is important. However, is our physical health and our physical death the #1 concern in our brief lives on earth? If so, that focus is far too worldly and not enough other worldly.

With that in mind, those two should not be the **primary** fears in any person's life. If not those, then what should be the #1 concern/fear in our lives? Jesus speaks very plainly and clearly about this in the Gospel of St. Luke: *I tell you, my friends, do not be afraid of those who kill the body but after that can do no more. I shall show you whom to fear. Be afraid of the one who after killing has the power to cast into Gehenna* (in another word, hell); yes, I tell you, be afraid of that one. (Luke 12:4-5)

*The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom*. (Proverbs 9:10) This is not the fear of a slave, but the fear of a child who does not want to displease his parent. Such is the fear that we need to strive to cultivate daily in our lives.

So, there should be a healthy fear in our lives, a spiritually healthy fear, and that is fear of displeasing the Lord, of persisting in disobedience, a fear of the loss of Heaven. Is our #1 fear in our lives disobeying God, offending God? Such fear is a good sign of spiritual health.

Whenever I echo one of Jesus' difficult teachings, especially about the reality of eternity in Heaven or Hell, I try to include the reminder of His mercy, to never despair. He is *always* waiting to forgive, waiting for us to turn from our sins and to return to Him. Please never forget that our Lord is merciful. However, His mercy is not unconditional. Does that shock you? A necessary part of our receiving His mercy is of course our sincere sorrow for



having disobeyed Him, our repentance, our conversion, to sincerely strive to break free from any sinful habits...with the help of His grace, of course.

May we all seek to be pleasing to the Lord, with the help of His grace, to love Him with our whole being and to strive to love our neighbor as ourselves.

*...He [Jesus] became the source of eternal salvation for all who obey Him.* (Hebrews 5:9)
