# October 27, 2024 30th Sunday in Ordinary Time

## **Praying for the Holy Souls**

As we enter the month of November this week, the Church reminds us and encourages us during this time to perform a particular Spiritual Work of Mercy, praying for the Holy Souls in Purgatory. Let's be clear here. This Work should be performed frequently throughout the year. However, since we face many, many distractions in our daily lives, the Church, being a loving Mother, sets aside this month to remind us to aid those who have died, those who can greatly benefit from our prayers and our sacrifices.

The Church has consistently and faithfully taught that Purgatory exists and that some souls, ultimately destined for Heaven, do go there. Heaven and Hell are everlasting. Purgatory is not. We can hasten those souls' release.

\* Where is Purgatory in the Bible? Indeed, the word "Purgatory" is not found in the Bible. To repeat a key fact: we need to remember, not every Church teaching is found in the Bible. It need not be. Yes, the Holy Bible is the inspired, inerrant word of God and we as Catholics venerate this great gift. However, it is important for us to remember that Jesus commissioned the Apostles to teach, and that commission continues to this day in the One, Holy, Catholic, and Apostolic Church. The Church, under the guidance and protection of the Holy Spirit continues to teach the faith and do so without error, even though the Church continues to struggle to live the faith...since we're all sinners. The canon (i.e., list of books) of the Bible was given to us, yes, by the Holy Spirit, but God did this through the Church, tapping into Her Christ-given Apostolic authority.

\* What is Purgatory? The Catechism of the Catholic Church defines Purgatory as a "purification, so as to achieve the holiness necessary to enter the joy of heaven," which is experienced by those "who die in God's grace and friendship, but still imperfectly purified" (CCC 1030). It notes that "this final purification of the elect is entirely different from the punishment of the damned" (CCC 1031). https://www.catholic.com/tract/purgatory

In writing about Heaven in the Book of Revelation, St. John teaches that ...nothing unclean will enter it. (Rev. 21:27) We must be 100% pure to live in the holy presence of God forever. 99% is a good start, but it is not enough. (In considering the state of my own soul, I pray that I have zero unconfessed mortal sins on my soul. However, 100% pure? Nope. Lord, have mercy.)

Since many souls are imperfect at the moment of death, their souls must be purified before entering Heaven. That purification, that state, the Church calls Purgatory. All souls who die in the state of grace, that is, in right relationship with God with no mortal sins on their souls, are destined for everlasting life in Heaven. However, if they are not yet perfected (venial sin?) or have not made sufficient reparation for forgiven sin, they require a final purification before entering the presence of our All Holy God.

We can and we should help the Holy Souls attain Heaven asap, through our prayers (especially offering the perfect prayer, the Mass) and our sacrifices. If indeed the soul has already attained Heaven, prayer is never wasted. God can and will apply the fruits of our prayers to someone who needs the help, perhaps to someone for whom no one is praying! What an act of charity that is, a true Spiritual Work of Mercy.

Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine on them.
