2025 - Jubilee Year of Hope

(a very high-level view for now)

Pope Francis announced this Jubilee Year of Hope, 2025, way back in February 2022: "We must fan the flame of hope that has been given us and help everyone to gain new strength and certainty by looking to the future with an open spirit, a trusting heart and far-sighted vision. The forthcoming Jubilee can contribute greatly to restoring a climate of hope and trust as a prelude to the renewal and rebirth that we so urgently desire..."

The concept of a jubilee year dates back many centuries, deep into the Old Testament. Such a period is mentioned in the Book of Leviticus (25:8-13). In this Old Testament case a jubilee year was to take place every 50 years.

Now, a jubilee occurs at least once every 25 years in the Church.

What is a Jubilee Year?

A jubilee is a special time of reconciliation, forgiveness, and healing, first and foremost with God, and...with neighbor.

Reconciliation with God of course begins by acknowledging our sins, seeking reconciliation with God, seeking His forgiveness, especially in the Sacrament of Penance/*Reconciliation*, asking God to heal the wounds our sins have caused.

Reconciliation with neighbor? That starts with prayer for them and for us, and then includes forgiveness, including forgiveness of those who have hurt us in any way. (Note: forgiveness does not mean denying any wrongdoing. Forgiveness is primarily focused on mercy directed towards the person who has wronged us.)

The faithful are strongly encouraged to make a pilgrimage(s) during jubilee years in order to obtain special graces, among such graces are indulgences. (We will revisit the Church's teachings on indulgences over the coming weekends. Not enough room here.)

The Vatican is the main pilgrimage site for this year. However, for those of us who cannot travel to Rome, the Church provides local sites to which we can more reasonably make pilgrimages. Archbishop Aquila has designated nine Archdiocesan parishes that will serve as pilgrimage site this year. Among them is St. Anthony in Sterling and St. Helena in Fort Morgan. No doubt we will be welcoming pilgrims over the coming months.

This jubilee year ends on December 24, 2025.
