
In Preparation for Holy Week

(which starts on Sunday, April 13)

In Advent 2024 we offered a brief faith study program at St. Anthony's on the topic of Advent led by Dr. Brant Pitre in order to prepare to better celebrate that holy season. For me it was time well-spent. I believe the same can be said for others who attended these classes.

Since Lent too is a time of preparation, I searched for a Lenten study series on Dr. Pitre's website. To my surprise I couldn't find one. However, what I DID find did pique my interest, and hopefully it will do the same for you.

It's entitled "The Jewish Roots of Holy Week: The 7 Last Days of Jesus."



What caught my attention is the outline for this brief study:

- 1. Palm Sunday: Why did Jesus ride into Jerusalem on a donkey?
- 2-3. **Holy Monday-Tuesday**: Why did Jesus curse the fig tree on holy Monday?
- 4. **Spy Wednesday**: What is the hidden meaning to Judas' betrayal of Jesus? And why is this day called "Spy Wednesday"?
- 5. **Holy Thursday**: How exactly did the disciples prepare the Passover for Jesus?
- 6. **Good Friday**: What is the meaning of the blood and water that flowed from Jesus' side?
- 7. **Holy Saturday**: Why did Jesus rest in the tomb? Where did Jesus' soul go on Holy Saturday?
- 8. Easter Sunday: Why did Jesus rise on the "first day of the week"?

While the stories behind some of these days are pretty familiar to us, can we say the same for all 8 days? Do all of us have the answers to the questions that are posed above? I know I certainly don't! Since that's the case and I want to learn more about this most holy week of the year, I am truly looking forward to this brief course. I hope you are as well.

The classes will meet on two Tuesdays, March 25 and April 1, starting at 6:30 PM in St. Anthony's cafeteria. Both classes will last approximately 75 minutes, each consisting of a 50-minute video, with time for discussion.

There will be no signup sheet for this class since we do not need to purchase workbooks. Handouts for the class will be provided.

There will be a follow-up class on Tuesday of Easter Week, April 22, "The Jewish Roots of Jesus Death and Resurrection," one class. More information about that yet to come. May we all spend a very holy Holy Week.
