[Here are just a few Scripture passages to help us as we enter into and journey through Lent.]

Remember you are dust, and to dust you shall return. (Genesis 3:19b)

This is the time of fulfillment. The kingdom of God is at hand. Repent, and believe in the gospel. (Mark 1:15)

If we say, "We are without sin," we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. (1 John 1:8)

Do I indeed derive any pleasure from the death of the wicked? says the Lord God. Do I not rather rejoice *when he turns from his evil way that he may live*? For I have no pleasure in the death of anyone who dies, says the Lord God. *Return and live*! (Ezekiel 18:23,32)

His mercy is from age to age to those who fear him. (Luke 1:50)

Give thanks to the Lord for he is good, his mercy endures forever! (Psalm 107:1)

Merciful and gracious is the Lord, slow to anger, abounding in mercy. (Psalm 103:8)

Repent, therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be wiped away. (Acts 3:19)

[To the woman caught in adultery] Jesus to her, "Woman, where are they? Has no one condemned you?" She replied, "No one, sir." Then Jesus said, "Neither do I condemn you. Go, and from now on do not sin any more." (John 8:10-11)

Guidelines for Fasting & Abstinence during Lent

People aged 18 to 59 are to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, and everyone over the age of 14 are to abstain from eating meat on Fridays during

Lent. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal. Two smaller meals may be taken instead, but they are not to equal a full meal.
