# Lent 2025

[Here are just a few Scripture passages to help us as we enter into and journey through Lent.]

Remember you are dust, and to dust you shall return. (Genesis 3:19b)

This is the time of fulfillment. The kingdom of God is at hand. Repent, and believe in the gospel. (Mark 1:15)

If we say, "We are without sin," we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. (1 John 1:8)

Do I indeed derive any pleasure from the death of the wicked? says the Lord God. Do I not rather rejoice *when he turns from his evil way that he may live?* For I have no pleasure in the death of anyone who dies, says the Lord God. *Return and live!* (Ezekiel 18:23,32)

His mercy is from age to age to those who fear him. (Luke 1:50)

Give thanks to the Lord for he is good, his mercy endures forever! (Psalm 107:1)

Merciful and gracious is the Lord, slow to anger, abounding in mercy. (Psalm 103:8)

Repent, therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be wiped away. (Acts 3:19)

[To the woman caught in adultery] Jesus to her, "Woman, where are they? Has no one condemned you?" She replied, "No one, sir." Then Jesus said, "Neither do I condemn you. Go, and from now on do not sin any more." (John 8:10-11)

God has overlooked the times of ignorance, but now he demands that all people everywhere repent. (Acts 17:30)

We implore you on behalf of Christ, be reconciled to God. (2 Cor 5:20b)

I tell you, in just the same way there will be more joy in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine righteous people who have no need of repentance. (Luke 15:7)

Be not impatient in prayers, and neglect not the giving of alms. (Sirach 7:10)

But do not ignore this one fact, beloved, that with the Lord one day is like a thousand years and a thousand years like one day. **Guidelines for Fasting & Abstinence during Lent**

People aged 18 to 59 are to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, and everyone over the age of 14 are to abstain from eating meat on Fridays during

Lent. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal. Two smaller meals may be taken instead, but they are not to equal a full meal.

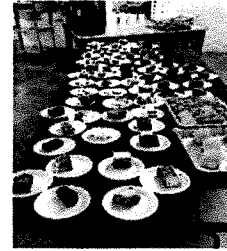


