Which flower, of all the flowers in the world, is the most beautiful?

Beauty is, of course, in the eyes of the beholder. So, your answer could be the Dahlia, the Tulip, a Rose, the Lotus Flower, an Orchid or even an Iris. There are so many stunningly beautiful and breathtaking flowers in this wonderful world that God has given us.



But one flower you may not have considered is the lowly Dandelion. I propose that the Dandelion, one of the humblest of flowers, is the most beautiful flower in the world, in the hands of a young child as he or she gives it to their mother as a gift from the heart.

Unconditional love, in the form of a humble flower, that a mother recognizes as pure love from the heart of their child. The common Dandelion is the most beautiful of flowers and gifts of love, in the world.

Of course, all this talk of flowers reminds us of Saint Therese of Lisieux, The Little Flower. Some of her famous quotes "The splendour of the rose and the whiteness of the lily do not rob the little violet of its scent nor the daisy of its simple charm. If every tiny flower wanted to be a rose, spring would lose its loveliness." And "It pleases Him to create great Saints, who may be compared with the lilies or the rose; but He has also created little ones, who must be content to be daisies or violets, nestling at His feet to delight His eyes when He should choose to look at them. The happier they are to be as He wills, the more perfect they are."

For today, Mothers' Day, she has more direct things to say, "The loveliest masterpiece of the heart of God is the heart of a mother." And "In trial or difficulty I have recourse to Mother Mary, whose glance alone is enough to dissipate every fear."

On this Mothers' Day, we honor all mothers, and we offer them flowers and other gifts of love, from the heart, where all true gifts originate. But I would also ask that today, we all spend a moment in prayer to our Mother Mary, who Jesus gave all His disciples, yes, that includes us, as our mother from the cross on Calvary when He told His mother and the Apostle John "Woman, behold, your son." Then he said to the disciple, "Behold, your mother.".

Today, Mothers' Day, remember all the mothers in your life, honor them, give them gifts from the heart but don't forget to remember our Mother Mary, and the great gift she gave us from the depths of her heart, her Son, Jesus Christ.

Today I am announcing a special Called by Name Campaign to identify faithful young men in our archdiocese who, through God's providence, could have a vocation to the priesthood. The campaign will take place on May 17-18, 2025.

While our archdiocese has been blessed with many good priests, we still have a need for "more workers for the harvest."
