### Storm the Gates of Heaven

The Church enters a momentous period this coming Wednesday, May 7 as some 135 Cardinals begin this most recent conclave in order to elect the 266th Successor of St. Peter to continue to shepherd the Church. I firmly believe that we the faithful play an active and important role in this moment in history. Of course that is through our frequent and fervent prayer for the Cardinals, for the Church. Indeed, the Cardinals have requested our prayers. (See below.) So, let us storm the gates of Heaven, *daily*, with our petitions - for love of God and for love of His Bride, the Church.

## STATEMENT OF THE HOLY SEE

issued on April 30, 2025

The College of Cardinals gathered in Rome, engaged in the General Congregations in preparation for the Conclave, wishes to invite the People of God to live this ecclesial moment as an event of grace and spiritual discernment, listening to the will of God.

For this reason, the Cardinals, conscious of the responsibility to which they are called, feel the need to be supported by the prayers of all the faithful. This is the true force that in the Church promotes the unity of all the members of the one Body of Christ (cf. 1 Cor 12:12).

Faced with the enormity of the task ahead and the urgency of the present time, it is first of all necessary to make ourselves humble instruments of the infinite wisdom and providence of our Heavenly Father, in docility to the action of the Holy Spirit. Indeed, He is the protagonist of the life of the People of God, the One to whom we must listen, accepting what He is saying to the Church (cf. Rev 3:6).

May the Blessed Virgin Mary accompany these prayers with her maternal intercession.

I kneel before you, O Virgin Mother of God, Our Lady of Guadalupe, the compassionate mother of all who love you, cry to you, seek you, and trust in you. I plead for the Church at a time of great trial and danger for her. As you came to the rescue of the Church at Tepeyac in 1531, please intercede for the Sacred College of Cardinals gathered in Rome to elect the Successor of Saint Peter, Vicar of Christ, Shepherd of the Universal Church.

At this tumultuous time for the Church and for the world, plead with your Divine Son that the Cardinals of the Holy Roman Church, His Mystical Body, will humbly obey the promptings of the Holy Spirit. Through your intercession, may they choose the most worthy man to be Christ's Vicar on earth. With you, I place all my trust in Him Who alone is our help and salvation. Amen.


