Essays on Prayer number 3 July 20, 2025



Today we discuss the "Our Father", the prayer that Jesus taught us. This prayer is found in Matthew, the Sermon on the Mount, and has seven petitions. Thomas Aquinas tells us "The Lord's Prayer is the most perfect of prayers...we ask, not only for all the things we can rightly desire, but also in the sequence that they should be desired....".

We will go through the Our Father phrase by phrase to gain a deeper understanding of the prayer. All the following is taken from the Catechism of the Catholic Church except where noted.

"Our Father" – we, children of God, pray together to God in humility. We pray in a father-child covenantal relationship to "...the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ.".

"Who Art in Heaven" – not a place but a state of being, God is majestic, He transcends everything. t Augustine says "...rightly understood to mean that God is in the hearts of the just, as in his holy temple.". Heaven is where God dwells.

THE SEVEN PETITIONS

"Hallowed Be Thy Name" – we recognize that even God's name is holy. This petition can be understood as praise and thanksgiving but is also a petition, a desire and an expectation. "...our life and our prayer..." depend on "The sanctification of his name...." as "We ask God to hallow his name, which by its own holiness saves and makes holy all creation....It is this name that gives salvation to a lost world." St Peter Chrysologus.

"Thy Kingdom Come" – The Kingdom of God "...lies ahead of us.... [and] has come in Christ's Death and Resurrection." (a paradox). Here we refer to the Kingdom of God coming in glory and "...the final coming of the reign of God through Christ's return."

"Thy Will Be Done On Earth As It Is In Heaven" – The Will of God is to love God and love our neighbor. "By prayer we can discern "what is the will of God" and obtain the endurance to do it.".

"Give Us This Day Our Daily Bread" – the trust of children in relationship with the Father. A petition and a prayer of intercession for all to be given nourishment, both material and spiritual.

"And Forgive Us Our Trespasses, As We Forgive Those Who Trespass Against Us" — Remarkable, we are asking that "...our petition will not be heard unless we have first..." forgiven others. If we do not forgive others "...our hearts are closed and their hardness makes them impervious to the Father's merciful love....".

"And Lead Us Not Into Temptation" – The Greek here actually means ""do not allow us to enter into temptation" and "do not let us yield to temptation."" God does not and will not "lead" us into temptation. "But Deliver Us From Evil" – We pray "...for the deliverance of the

whole human family." from evil, Satan, the Evil One and know that evil is not an abstraction but is real.
