Essays on Prayer August 10, 2025 no. 6



Lectio Divina is a form of prayer that has been part of Christianity for about seventeen hundred years. Once only practiced by monks and religious it is now accessible to all Catholics and supports the direction given in the Catechism of the Catholic Church "The Church "forcefully and specially exhorts all the Christin faithful...to learn "the surpassing knowledge of Jesus Christ" (Phil 3:8) by frequent reading of the divine Scriptures....Let them remember, however, that prayer should accompany the reading of Sacred Scripture, so that a dialogue takes place between God and man."". Lectio Divina, Divine Reading, gives structure to that dialogue.

There are four movements, or five steps depending on the source (multiple sources were used in the writing of this essay), involved in Lectio Divina, Prepare (Silencio), Read (Lectio), Meditate (Meditatio), Pray (Oratio), and Contemplate (Contemplatio).

To prepare (Silencio) set aside some quiet time, about 30 minutes, away from daily activities, the television, the computer, away from anything that can distract or interrupt your prayer time. Find a place that allows you to focus on God and His Word and select a Scripture Reading of your choosing.

Slowly read the bible verse (Lectio) or passage that you have selected and note anything that stands out or makes an impression on you as you are reading. Now, go back and read the passage a second time slowly dwelling on those areas, words, phrases that stood out the first time (Mediatatio). Don't try to analyze what you are reading, just let God talk to you and let Him tell you what He wants you to hear. Just listen, meditate or focus on what you have read. A variation is to put yourself, through your imagination, in the scene of the bible passage you just read. Place yourself at the Nativity, the Wedding Feast at

Cana, the Transfiguration etc. What you see, feel, hear may be a very personal experience of God and will bring you closer to Him.

Then read the passage a third time. Now it is time to respond or pray (Oratio). You can do this several ways. Pray based on what God has had you focus on and begin a conversation with Him. See what more He tells you and how He wants you to respond. You could also journal about what God has revealed to you which helps a person internalize God's message. Be open to how God wants you to respond.

Finally, after reading the passage a fourth time, end the time with God in quiet contemplation (Contemplatio). Don't pray or meditate, just let God work in the silence of your heart. If your mind begins to wander, that is okay, just gently lead it back to resting in God.

The goal of Lectio Divina is the same as all prayer, to deepen our relationship with God. This form of prayer specifically helps us hear God speak to us through His Divine Word, Sacred Scripture.
