## Saint Teresa of Jesus, Virgin and Doctor

1515-1582

Patron Saint of Spain, lacemakers, and those in need of grace, in religious orders, and ridiculed for their piety

Canonized by Pope Gregory XV on March 12, 1622 Declared a Doctor of the Church on Sept. 27, 1970 Feast day—October 15:

Let us imagine, then, that this castle has several mansions, or rooms; some above, some below, and others on the sides, and that in the center of all these is the principal room, in which subjects of the greatest secrecy are discussed between God and the soul. You should often reflect on this comparison; for perhaps our Lord may be pleased that I should help you by means thereof, to understand something regarding those favors He is pleased to bestow on souls, and what difference there is in them; this I may be able to explain, as far as my understanding can reach; but it is impossible for one to understand them all, because there are many, and how much more for a person so ignorant as I am? ~Saint Teresa, Interior Castle



## Saint Ignatius of Antioch, Bishop and Martyr

Patron Saint of the Church in Northern Africa and the Eastern Mediterranean Pre-Congregation canonization Feast Day—October 17

I am writing to all the churches to let it be known that I will gladly die for God if only you do not stand in my way. I plead with you: show me no untimely kindness. Let me be food for the wild beasts, for they are my way to God. I am God's wheat and bread. Pray to Christ for me that the animals will be the means of making me a sacrificial victim for God. No earthly pleasures, no kingdoms of this world can benefit me in any way. I prefer death in Christ Jesus to power over the farthest limits of the earth. ~Saint Ignatius, letter to the Romans

First Century, died c. age 84
Patron Saint of artists, bachelors, bookbinders, brewers, butchers, glassworkers, goldworkers, laceworkers, notaries, physicians, and surgeons Pre-Congregation canonization
Feast Day—October 18


