THE COMMEMORATION OF ALL THE FAITHFUL DEPARTED

ON THAT DAY OF JUDGEMENT

Physical death is a reality that awaits all of us. As human beings, we possess both the body and soul. While our physical body at the end of our physical life is reduced to ashes, our soul is eternal.

The catechism of the Catholic Church teaches us that the soul is the spiritual principle of our human person, created immediately by God and is immortal. It does not perish at death but will be reunited with the body in the final resurrection (both are two aspects of a single nature).

We have just commemorated and prayed for the souls of the faithful departed and this reminds us of our own soul too. Have you ever asked yourself, "In what condition will my physical death find my soul?". The readings that we shall be listening in the days to come during Mass are not meant to scare us but rather, to challenge us in the way in which we care for both our body and soul. They present to us a reality in life that awaits us all. All of us will have to face the divine tribunal individually and to give an account of how we lived our faith and how we related to one another.

I remember someone once told me, "Father, I don't want us to talk about death. Let's talk about other issues of life but not death." And I had to remind him that talking about death does not either invite it or keep it away. When our time comes, our soul shall separate from our body.

The word of God reminds us always that our actions and our life here on earth determine how we shall be judged. Aware that we shall all be subjected to the final judgement individually, we should, therefore, constantly evaluate our life, i.e., our relationship with God and with one another. The Gospel according to St. Matthew, for example reminds us of what we need to do: love and care for others, especially the poor and those discarded by the society. In the Gospel according to John 3, 18, we read [Whoever believes in Him is not condemned, but whoever does not is condemned already because he has not believed in the name of the only Son of God].

Meaning, as we live, we should always mend our relationship with God and brothers. We should never be afraid; God is love and He wants all of us to be saved. My dear brethren, God is giving us time today. We do not know if we shall still have that time tomorrow.

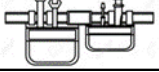
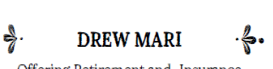
