Feast of the Baptism of the Lord

Matthew 3:13-17

Jewish Baptism

The Jewish baptism is rooted in ancient practices of ritual immersion. **The baptism in Jewish tradition is the practice of *mikveh*, a ritual bath used for purification.** In ancient Israel immersion in water was a means of restoring ritual purity, especially after becoming unclean due to various circumstances, for example, after having contact with a corpse. Specific requirements for these immersions emphasize the use of "living water" (natural sources) for the most effective purification. At the beginning of the 1st Century of the Christian Era, John the Baptist called people to immerse in the waters of the River Jordan as a sign of repentance and preparation for the coming of the long-expected Messiah. John's practice of baptism is a calling for a moral reform and spiritual readiness. His actions elevate the meaning of immersion from a routine purification to a profound act of repentance and commitment to God.

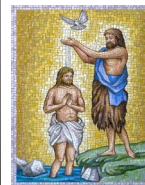
Christian Baptism

The Christian Baptism is the practice of a ritual immersion in "living water". This practice is called Sacrament, a means of sanctification. Instituted by Christ, *"go and make disciples of all peoples baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit"* *Matthew 28:19-20*, the Christian baptism is the sacrament that initiate us in the Christian life; it makes us children of God and members of the Church.

The Baptism of Jesus

The Baptism of Jesus is an Epiphany, *"This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased"*, *Matthew 3:17*. Epiphany is the act of Revelation of God as he is; the voice of the Father, the descend of the Holy Spirit and the proclamation of Jesus as The beloved Son of the God the Father. The purpose of the Baptism of Jesus is to fulfil God's will, *"for thus it is fitting for us to fulfill all righteousness"* *Matthew 3:15*.

Fiesta del Bautismo del Señor

Mateo 3:13-17

Bautismo judío

El bautismo judío tiene sus raíces en prácticas antiguas de inmersión ritual. **El bautismo en la tradición judía es la práctica del *mikve*, un baño ritual utilizado para la purificación.** En el antiguo Israel, la inmersión en agua era un medio para restaurar la pureza ritual, especialmente después de volverse impuro debido a diversas circunstancias, por ejemplo, tras tener contacto con un cuerpo. Los requisitos específicos para estas inmersiones enfatizan el uso de "agua viva" (fuentes naturales) para la purificación más eficaz. A principios del siglo I de la era cristiana, Juan el Bautista llamó a la gente a sumergirse en las aguas del río Jordán como señal de arrepentimiento y preparación para la venida del tan esperado Mesías. La práctica del bautismo de Juan es una llamada a una reforma moral y a la preparación espiritual. Sus acciones elevan el significado de la inmersión de una purificación rutinaria a un acto profundo de arrepentimiento y compromiso con Dios.

Bautismo cristiano

El Bautismo cristiano es la práctica de una inmersión ritual en "agua viva". Esta práctica se llama Sacramento, un medio de santificación. Instituido por Cristo, *"id y haced discípulos de todos los pueblos, bautizándolos en el nombre del Padre, del Hijo y del Espíritu Santo"* *Mateo 28:19-20*, el bautismo cristiano es el sacramento que nos inicia en la vida cristiana; nos hace hijos de Dios y miembros de la Iglesia.

El Bautismo de Jesús

El Bautismo de Jesús es una Epifanía: *"Este es mi Hijo amado, en quien me complazco"*, *Mateo 3:17*. La Epifanía es el acto de la Revelación de Dios tal como es, la voz del Padre, el descenso del Espíritu Santo y la proclamación de Jesús como el Hijo amado de Dios Padre. El propósito del Bautismo de Jesús es cumplir la voluntad de Dios, *"porque así nos es apropiado cumplir toda justicia"* *Mateo 3:15*.
