What is in a Name?

Shakespeare wrote, "What's in a name? That which we call a rose by any other name would smell as sweet." In this famous scene from **Romeo and Juliet**, Juliet reflects on how a rose would still be a rose even if it were called something else. This raises an important question: **are names really that important?**

God seems to think so. Scripture shows us the importance of a name when the angel tells Mary, "You shall name him Jesus." The name **Jesus** means "God saves," revealing His very mission—to save us from sin. Throughout the Bible and in our Church, names carry deep meaning and purpose. Everything has a name—from people, to towns, to holy places. Jesus Himself even changed people's names, such as **Saul to Paul**, to mark a new identity and mission.

Jesus is known by many names throughout Scripture, and each one reveals something about who He is and how He loves us. He is called **Emmanuel**, meaning "God with us," reminding us that God chose to dwell among His people. He is the **Son of God**, showing His divine nature, and the **Son of Man**, revealing His closeness to humanity. Jesus is also called the **Messiah or Christ**, meaning "the Anointed One," the long-awaited Savior promised by God.

Other titles help us understand how Jesus guides and cares for us. He is the **Good Shepherd**, who knows His sheep and lays down His life for them. He is the **Lamb of God**, who takes away the sins of the world through His sacrifice. Jesus calls Himself the **Light of the World**, showing us the path out of darkness, and the **Bread of Life**, who nourishes our souls and gives us eternal life.

The Catholic Church continues to honor the power and meaning of Jesus' name. Each month of the year is dedicated to a special devotion, and the month of **January is dedicated to the Holy Name of Jesus**, reminding us that His name is holy, powerful, and worthy of reverence. When we speak the name of Jesus with faith, we call upon His presence, His mercy, and His saving power. As Catholics, we are encouraged to pray often using His Holy Name, trusting in the promise that "at the name of Jesus every knee should bend" (Philippians 2:10).

O glorious Name of Jesus,

name above all names,

through Your holy Name grant us protection, strength, and peace.

May Your Name be our comfort in sorrow,

our refuge in temptation,

and our hope in every trial.

Jesus, Savior of the world,

have mercy on us.

May we honor Your Holy Name

in word, in thought, and in deed,

now and forever.
