PEACE BE WITH YOU

April 12, 2026
SECOND SUNDAY OF EASTER
Divine Mercy Sunday

“As the Father has sent me, so I send you.”

And when he had said this, he breathed on them and said to them, “Receive the Holy Spirit; whose sins you forgive, they are forgiven; those who are withheld by you are retained.”

In the Gospel accounts of the recognition of the Risen One, the disciples tell us how they have had personal or community encounters with Jesus full of life; as Jesus, who had been hidden by the clutches of death, gives them a new opportunity, he meets them alive again. It was the same, but not the same.

He who had called them, had invited them to follow him, had proposed to them the plan of his kingdom, and they had abandoned after the scandal of the cross. He offers them salvation, liberation, renewal again. What is decisive is that they remember the words of Jesus, his attitudes on the long walks in Galilee, as WORDS, DEEDS OF HIM WHO IS ALIVE AND CONTINUES TO SPEAK TO THEM WITH THE POWER OF THE SPIRIT.

The Resurrection gives the life of Jesus a permanent, timely timeliness: he continues to forgive, calling us to follow him; welcoming the poor.

The disciples felt regenerated: they lived praying, sharing, in an incredible fraternity and unity that led them to perform signs and wonders in the name of the Risen One. Overcoming their fears of opening themselves to life, they returned to Galilee, preceded by Him, with Him at the center, with a fuller faith for their life and evangelizing mission.

Returning to Jerusalem was the easiest thing, it was returning to the institutional, the regulated, to compliance. To begin anew in Galilee is to announce the possibility of a more humane, compassionate, merciful and supportive world.

It is to continue trusting in the value of service, of the witness of the truth; it is to have true passion for the crucified of our world; it is to accept the failure of the cross as a way of life and happiness.
