Happy Pentecost!

This might seem like a strange way to begin a bulletin front, but Pentecost is truly a time of celebration and reflection on our faith and where it comes from.

Pentecost, by definition, is a celebration. It is the moment when the Apostles came out of hiding and began their public ministry. In many ways, it is the birthday of the Church.

Before Jesus ascended into Heaven, He instructed the Apostles to remain in Jerusalem and wait for the Holy Spirit whom He had promised. So they waited together in prayer and hope.

Then came Pentecost.

The Holy Spirit revealed Himself in powerful ways. First came a mighty rushing wind. Then tongues of fire appeared over each of them, and they began speaking in languages they had never known before. People from many nations heard the Apostles speaking and understood them in their own languages. Through the power of the Holy Spirit, the Apostles were able to go out into the world proclaiming the Gospel so that all people could hear and understand the message of Christ.

But Pentecost is not only something that happened long ago. The same Holy Spirit continues to move in the Church today. We are still called to go out and proclaim the Gospel by the way we live, speak, serve, and love others. Through our words and actions, we are invited to help others encounter Christ and know His love.

One of the beautiful ways the Holy Spirit continues to work within us is through the gifts and fruits of the Spirit. In Baptism, and strengthened in Confirmation, we receive the seven gifts of the Holy Spirit: wisdom, understanding, counsel, fortitude, knowledge, piety, and fear of the Lord. These gifts guide and strengthen us as we strive to live as faithful disciples of Christ. When we allow the Holy Spirit to work within us, these gifts begin to bear fruit in our daily lives. The fruits of the Holy Spirit — love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control — become visible in the way we treat others and carry ourselves in the world. Through the Holy Spirit, God not only equips us for mission, but also transforms our hearts to become more like Christ.

As we celebrate Pentecost, may we pray for a renewed outpouring of the Holy Spirit upon our parish, our families, and ourselves. May the Spirit give us the courage of the Apostles, the wisdom to share our faith, and hearts open to wherever God is calling us to serve.

Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of Your faithful
and kindle in them the fire of Your love.
Send forth Your Spirit and they shall be created.
And You shall renew the face of the earth.

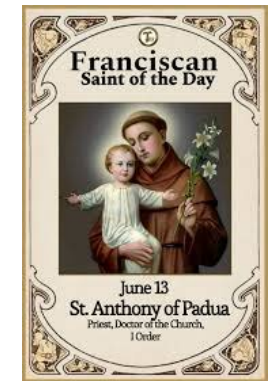
